KASAB SPEAKS
 THE INNER VICTIM/TERRORIST
 A THANKSGIVING BLESSING

(Note: Kasab, the terrorist who had been captured after 26/11, had been hanged prior to the meeting. As the group begins chanting OM, Sohrab started crying)

🔴 (Kasab) Muje maaf karo! Mai kaha hoon? Muje kuch bhi nahi dikhta –

(Sohrab shifts energies)

🔴 Dear friends, please continue to give him light: do so without judgment, only with compassion and understanding. Do not chant, just shower him with light. He is still energetically in the room: show him your light. (The group does so)--- Thank you.

This little traumatic moment was deliberately permitted, to see if you could continue to work in balance, despite the emotionality of the event... and you did. You were also able to offer him light, unconditionally, and without judgment. Well done.

Dear friends, he is in a state of turmoil and yes, your light and energy, and the light and energy of others, will serve him on his journey.

You may recall that we once spoke of the journey of the different terrorists. In some cases, they were simply following their life mission, and after completing this, they then passed over in complete balance and alignment.

Yet there were others who were meant to incarnate into these circumstances, and to then *move away* from the act of terrorism. He (Kasab) was one of these.

Yes, being trained as a terrorist, and being partially brain-washed, was his soul game plan. But he had hoped to touch his power and *not do the act* at the last minute.

This he was unable to do. He got swept away by the energies of his inculcation, and his rigid belief systems.

His greatest fear was not earthly, but divine, retribution. He did not fear his handlers as much as God. He was terrified that if he did not carry out this act, he would have to face a merciless, punishing God who would torment his soul.

Each time he raised his gun, an inner voice urged him not to do so: he was in complete imbalance and emotional turmoil.

His own beingness offered him a strong alternative choice, a strong possibility: he could have 'vanished' into the heartlands of India, lived like a Sadhu with a begging bowl, and used that option to grow and re-evaluate self and his indoctrination. Had he made this choice, he would never have been found. He did not take it.

Having chosen instead the 'incarceration' route, he offered himself the opportunity to spend a lengthy time in jail, re-evaluating self, his actions, his belief systems and his view of God. He also offered all others, world-wide, the opportunity to examine their views on terrorism, justice and compassion.


Though your newspapers report that he was 'laughing and singing' in jail, he has not passed over in peace, balance or self-realisation. Did he regret his act? Yes. Has he 'awoken' to self? Only partially.

He spent his jail sentence warring with himself. Though he began to 'see the bigger picture', the portion of self that was so indoctrinated in training and dogma kept dragging him down. He lived a schizophrenic existence there: he had moments, even hours, of balance, awareness and realization; and would then slip back, tormenting self with his old patterns and belief structures.

Though this has not been reported, he did (unsuccessfully) attempt suicide, several times over. He felt a complete failure, in life and in death. He was terrified of the upcoming retribution of a vengeful God.

Having now passed over, he is unsure of where he is. The afterlife is not quite what he expected it to be.

What is he experiencing?

 As you well know, when you pass over, you energetically thought-create any comforting image to help you accept your 'return home'. Depending on your beliefs, you may therefore create 'heaven', 'hell' or simply blackness (if you believe in 'ashes-to-ashes')

In his case, as he passed over in confusion and turmoil, he has currently created for self an 'energetic sandstorm'. He is experiencing confusing energies whirling around self, which are further scrambling his thoughts.

Masters and guides are, of course, there to help; but he is not permitting them to approach or assist him. He has to find a relative level of inner balance before he will be open to their assistance. And they do not violate his space, as his will is sacred.

I don't quite understand this!

■ As above, so below. When you are in complete panic on Earth, are you able to see clearly, or access help that may be at hand? No. It is only when you calm down a little that you can do so.

It is exactly the same with him. He has to touch his power and to find a modicum of balance before he can allow the Masters to assist him. At the moment he is keeping all 'at arm's length' as he does not even feel worthy enough to get help. He feels he deserves punishment; hence he is creating it.

He will require several bouts of deep, healing sleep; in which he will be integrated into his own higher energies. It is only after that that he will be able to begin a process of self-reviewal, growth and expansion.

The sandstorm we spoke of is not entirely of his own making: it also consists of the anger and hatred that others still feel for him. Many on earth are indeed celebrating his death, or saying to self "Serves him right! He got what he deserved." This is also adding to his energetic whirlwind.

Considering that he had literally been brainwashed, how is he responsible for his actions? Why should he then have to go through all of this?

■ With your current level of power, dear friends, life is all about learning to touch your power and make personal choices.

Let us answer your questions from an external and an internal perspective. Externally, those who were killed by him also had higher-level choices; they were not 'victims of circumstance'. They desired violent deaths for personal growth reasons. Even then, at the last minute, at a higher level they would have reviewed their choices, and decided whether or not it was the 'right time' to go. If yes, in a split second they would have placed themselves in the firing line; and if not, the bullet would have missed them.

Now let us look at the internal, 'brainwashed' aspect. In an extreme case, when a person is completely and totally brain-washed, he is not responsible for his actions. But this rarely occurs. In this particular case, he still had a part of self that retained accountability for actions, and could make choices.

Approximately 70% of his psyche was influenced and controlled by external forces, like his handlers. A little less than 30% was still governed by self, his own integrity, his own personality, his own choices, and his own beingness.

His personal challenge was to touch his power and make a different choice. As described earlier, he could have done so, vanished into the heartlands of your country, and lived out his life in self-search.

He, however, succumbed to fear and a deep sense of worthlessness. How paradoxical that one who instils fear in another is filled with fear himself.

Surely 70/30 odds are very difficult to overcome?

That statement is now not acceptable, given your current level of evolution. You can triumph with even a 1% opportunity or desire to change. Also please remember that the '70/30 odds' were not imposed upon him, but were chosen by him, at a higher level! You only choose that which you can handle.

Dear friends, learn from this. ***All of you are 'brainwashed' in areas of your lives, to differing degrees.*** All the rigid structures, belief systems, habits and patterns you follow are varying degrees of brainwashing. Review these: are they ones you follow blindly, as they have been imposed upon you from childhood by parents or society; or have you truly made them your own? Else each one of these becomes your 'handler'.

From what I understand, he was taught that by carrying out his instructions, he would be immediately taken to God; yet that is not what he 'thought-created'.

Exactly! Part of self believed that, and was at war with the other, deeper part, that said "Something is wrong here: those strangers I kill could be my own mother or sister". He could not reconcile the two parts of self, hence he thought-created this conflict.

He was not a very intelligent man. This statement, by the way, is an observation, not a judgment. Had he allowed his innate intelligence to surface, he would have reasoned it out and not had a difficult choice to make. He had to suppress that aspect of his higher self, to learn to touch his power and work from gut.

As you may now understand, over lifetimes he had sunk into extreme victimhood. His greatest desire was to touch his power, and make choices from the fullness of self.

This victimhood caused his mind to play tricks: he convinced himself that by making the choice not to do the act, he would be a coward, and would disgrace himself in the eyes of Allah. He would not allow himself to see that by choosing not to do it, he would in fact be stronger and more empowered.

Dear friends, is this so difficult to understand? Don't you do this all the time? Play those convenient mind-games, and convince yourselves that what you are doing is exactly right for you, when, in fact, it may be taking you away from self?

Don't you often stand in a sandstorm of your own making, where a situation appears dire, traumatic and insoluble? And then, in hindsight, you look back and wonder why you didn't do something simply, that could have changed it entirely?

In his case, though the energies appear to be battering him relentlessly, they will slowly clear, partly due to his own awakening, and partly due to the help and unconditional generosity of friends like you.

Do not judge him: serve him as you would serve a loved one. Now once again, focus upon his energies and help clear the sandstorm. Give him light...thank you.

While you were working with him, did you pick up anything?

I got that he feels betrayed.

I got the feeling that he felt like he was being battered by invisible blows.

I saw him standing in front of me, asking me for forgiveness.

I experienced his utter helplessness. I felt that if he knew what to do, he would do it.

I experienced his utter confusion.


Did anyone sense his sense of being a 'confused child'?

(Many in the group nod in agreement)

Even in the spirit realm, he is playing the 'innocent, abused child'; and is once again attempting to shuffle off responsibility for his choices.

Rest assured that he is being watched over and guided. He must now learn to touch his power. As long as he continues to play the victim game, the sandstorm will continue to rage, and he will continue to experience pain and trauma. But the moment he desires to change, we will be at hand to guide him and nurture him.

His dying words were "Allah muje maaf karde" (Allah, forgive me): to which Allah was he praying? The forgiving one or the vengeful one?

 He was praying to both, as they both existed in his reality. At that moment, however, he most certainly began to acknowledge and embrace the true Allah within the self: his own God-centre.

Let us bless him for all that he has undergone, all that he had taught us, and continues to teach us.

Thank you for that acknowledgment, dear friend. Every person and every event that you create has something to offer you, and something to draw from you. Nothing is random.

You may wonder why he was moved to another city for the execution. Energetically, he desired to align himself with the energies of Pune. They are currently very vibrant: tectonic plates below the city have begun to shift, and crystalline beds deep under the surface have begun to irradiate energies to the city and all its inhabitants.

That city will undergo many changes in the future: there will also be a higher incidence of emotional conflicts and personal upheavals. Not all of these are going to be disturbing: some will be wonderfully expansive ones, in which people touch their love centres, their power, glory and creativity.

He deliberately chose this city, to help 'propel' self into the ether at an accelerated rate.

Should we continue to help him by giving him light?

You may joyously do so, if so you wish.

Dear friends: you have all brought yourselves to this meeting quite deliberately today. All of you, without exception, have, within self, a strong inner victim and inner terrorist. You also function, in many areas, in a 'brainwashed' manner.

Please examine your inner child over the next few weeks. ***Pay close attention to the inner 5-year old.*** Do not deceive yourselves with the "I don't remember" routine. Spend some time at home going within self, and explore your 5-year old. Allow yourselves to delve deep within: you may be surprised, shocked, alarmed or even thrilled with what you find. Be courageous. Be adventurous. Be daring.
